Mother Helpage specialises in emergency relief and rescue through its air, land and sea rescue units. Mother helpage has been in the forefront with other humanitarian agencies in conducting humanitarian relief services with sheer professionalism. Mother Helpage is a pioneer in this field not only in the UK but across the globe. In addition to rapid response Mother Helpage also provides post-

disaster counselling, disaster recovery courses and specialises in construction of disaster resilient shelter homes, schools and hospitals.

Mother Helpage has the following focus:

Global disaster response unit has over 400 volunteers across the world comprising professionals and students in various fields. Their focus is:

- 1- Worldwide volunteer recruitment for disaster response.
- 2- Volunteer training in disaster preparedness, emergency rescue and relief.
- 3- Post disaster counseling and training courses like ATLS, PHTLS etc.
- 3- Assigning key tasks to professional volunteers.
- 4- Preparation and awareness on professional fronts i.e. communication, recovery, triage and relief services, transportation, medical care and construction procedures during periods of disasters.







Vital Communication Network during Disasters.

- ❖ Communications infrastructure is vital when disaster strikes without which immediate relief efforts can be seriously hampered.
- ❖ Mother Helpage disaster response unit has played a key role in providing communication facilities during some of the worst disasters in recent times in particular Haiti, Pakistan and Indonesia.
- ❖ Mother Helpage is constantly looking at ways in improving and providing most reliable and state of the art communication systems during disasters and emergencies.
- ❖ Mother Helpage Disaster Response College based in London will be providing training courses on effective communication methods and procedures during the times of disaster.





Disaster Disability Reduction Programme:

Mother Helpage is amongst the one of the few charities which deals with the spectrum of the disaster from its start to its devastating after effects, which most of the organisations ignore. Following are the steps which Mother Helpage focuses during the disaster and it's after effects towards the reduction of disability.

- Evacuation of the critically injured and triage
- Provision of shelter homes for the IDP's, thus reducing overcrowding and further injuries
- ❖ Provision of orthopaedic appliances and other aid tools
- Post disaster counselling and rehabilitation briefings
- ❖ Women empowerment schemes to reduce psychosocial instability
- ❖ Various income generation schemes



The failure to provide safe drinking water and adequate sanitation services to all people is perhaps the greatest development failure of the 20th century. The most egregious consequence of this failure is the high rate of mortality from preventable water-related diseases. If no action is taken to address unmet basic human needs for water, as many as 135 million people could die from these diseases by 2020. Even if the explicit Millennium Goals announced by the United Nations in 2000 are achieved, unlikely given current international commitments, between 34 and 76 million people could perish from water related diseases by 2020.



Mother Helpage Worldwide has stood up to this challenge and has so far installed more than 7000 water sources in Niger, Mali, Sudan, Pakistan, Kashmir, India, Srilanka, Nepal and Indonesia. Mother Helpage in addition to this also has constructed hundreds of sanitation units in order to protect the sanity of females, the old and the environment.









Every year Mother Helpage conducts Ramadhan & Qurbani programmes in almost 20 countries, thus helping hundreds and thousands by providing food parcels and Qurbani (animal sacrifice) meat. Mother Helpage not only fulfills the religious obligations but also carry the awareness programmes about malnutrition and safer health.



Mother Helpage has been so far successful in implementing community development programmes thus helping not only individuals or this communities but aims high to make a real difference.

Mother Helpage Community Development Programmes:

* Rehabilitation Village in Srilanka: More than 200 houses were constructed in Musali Sri- lanka to rehabilitate the displaced community.



❖ Women Empowerment Projects: Mother Helpage is focusing on making communities self sustainable by providing income generation projects to the weaker sections of this society.



❖ Youth Development Projects: Mother Helpage is working hard on this project in order to keep the future of our civilisation away from anti-social activities and terrorism.



❖ Project for Special Children: Mother Helpage is at present taking care of almost five thousand children who are without their parents. These special children are provided with educational support, books, I.T equipment and miscellaneous living expenses. Mother Helpage is making special efforts to guide these special children to be the ambassadors of humanity in the future.



Environmental Friendly Projects: Mother Helpage is taking serious steps to improve the quality of life amongst the less fortunate. Mother Helpage has so far distributed thousands of solar- powered lanterns in Africa and Asia and has helped people to utilise this gift for income generation.



❖ Construction of Community Centers and Mosques: Mother Helpage is involved to bring the communities together by construction of community centers and mosques in order to promote communal harmony and togetherness. This project has helped in bridging relations between different races, religions & colors.



- Disaster Response- Mother Helpage is qualified to conduct disaster relief operations through its qualified staff by air, land and sea disaster response units, medical care during emergencies, communication during disasters and provision of disaster shelter homes.
- Training facility UK- Mother Helpage has commissioned a training facility in London through which disaster preparedness training will be provided to its overseas staff and various organisations dealing with disaster response in different countries. This training facility is the first of its kind in the world and will provide a post-graduate accredited course for disaster preparedness.
- Sea rescue academy in Indonesia- This sea rescue academy was started after the tsunami and has so far provided training to more than 3,000 volunteers regarding sea rescue procedures during disasters.
- *Air response team UK Mother Helpage Air response team in the UK provides information and training for its volunteers and trains them to conduct air relief operations during disasters.
- Land rescue units in different parts of the world- Mother Helpage has started the land rescue units in different parts of the world to ensure safety and emergency care for needy during the times of disaster.



Our main aims are to reach out to people of different faiths, governments and other governing and humanitarian bodies. We support partner organizations' advocacy for policy and legislative change both at national and International level. We aim to raise awareness and understanding in an international forum through available communication tools such as our website, as well as hosting events for activists, policymakers, media, and the public. Mother Helpage Worldwide is working on International fronts to support basic human needs in order to provide security and surety to the communities and the world.



- ❖ **Terrorism:** One of the major challenges in the present world and one which has taken a great toll of youth and has affected the world's stability. Mother Helpage is working with affected families, communities and countries to devise a policy of how to curb this epidemic across the globe.
- Child Labour: This has been defined as one of the worst epidemics of the modern world. When a child is mal-treated, they then have an inclination towards anti-social activities leading to terrorism etc. Mother Helpage Worldwide is currently conducting research on the relation between child labor and terrorism. Our aim and mission is to protect these innocent children and the world from any negative impact.
- ❖ Women Empowerment: Women play an important role in the development of civilisations and if the strength of the women is taken away from her then communities and civilisations head for failure. Mother Helpage is focusing on providing support to women in terms of individual development which in turn helps their communities to develop.
