

#### A NEW ERA | A NEW BEGINNING




Since the evolution of Mother Helpage, Dr. Sohail Nasti (Founder of the organisation) has worked hard to transform the lives of people by providing them with essential services.
































TOGETHER WE CAN ACHIEVE THESE GOALS

In support of the UN Sustainable Development Goals, Mother Helpage aims to install 3,000 water wells by the end of 2020, providing clean and safe drinking water in Jammu & Kashmir.

The motive of the project relies on providing access to safe water where this necessity is scarce and enhancing the levels of hygienic practices amongst the people.

Currently we are working in five major districts of Kashmir and are in the process of planning to reach several more as soon as we practically can.


Between 2015 and 2019 we have installed 1828 water wells all across Jammu & Kashmir and our mission is to complete the installation of 3000 water wells by the end of 2020 covering all the districts of Jammu & Kashmir.



Getting appropriate health check-ups and proper treatment is important for every human being. But unfortunately it just remains only a dream for the poor, health care services are too expensive and out of reach for the most vulnerable and disadvantaged.

One of our major concerns is the lack of awareness of how to access and utilise medical services that are available especially amongst people living in rural areas.

To overcome this problem MH organised free medical camps on sites in different areas of South Kashmir; Kulgam, Pulwama & Shopian in which free medical checkups and medicines were provided to the poor and underprivileged.

Our aim is to make people aware of their personal well-being so that they get the proper health care and education at the right time thus avoiding any long term health issues.

### MARRIAGE ASSISTANCE

Due to crushing poverty, countless families cannot afford to get their daughters married and as a result most of the girls have already crossed their marriageable age.

The extravaganza in marriages and one of the oldest social evils (excessive DOWRY) that is still prevailing are the main factors for late marriages and a big concern for the poor families. Communities are caught in social values and traditions, and they try to follow such trends, to evade disgrace. Unfortunately these cultural norms adds extra pressure, creating an extra burden for the lives of poor families.

Mother Helpage provides advice and financial assistance to the poor girls who cannot bear the expense of their marriage. Our sole aim is to ease their burden and re-educate communities on social norms that are not always necessary.

Mother Helpage under its Sponsorship Project has for many years and continues to support orphans, widows and the elderly by providing them with financial assistance on monthly basis.





Globally millions of people are homeless and spend their entire lives living on the streets. These are mostly vulnerable and require proper attention from society. Deprived of basic amenities these people suffer on regular basis with no access to food, clothes or medical facilities.
